SMARTBoard technology enables teachers to have their students complete interactive assignments in French class, to take an interactive quiz on the digestive system and to view virtual biology labs that simulate dissections.

Technology is integrated in to all aspects of the curriculum including:

- creating videos that promote the efficient use of energy resources
- using web quests in English class to promote inquiry-based learning of related topics
- experiencing multimedia presentations to explain accounting theories and principles
- viewing online videos in media arts class to experience critiques of images by professional photographers
- using graphing software in mathematics class to provide a visual representation of abstract concepts
- accessing websites to view a live simulation of a microorganism - an organism that they are not able to see with the naked eye.

Our online electronic course delivery system (MOODLE) provides students with access at school and at home to homework assignments, course notes, test review materials and course-related web links. The course calendars inform students of upcoming due dates in their courses to assist them with their time management skills.
